Articles to be considered for the special issues should be submitted electronically via the Journal's online <u>submission system</u> or sent to the editorial email <u>cwejournal@hse.ru</u>.

The submissions must not be under consideration by another journal or outlet. They will be reviewed by at least two anonymous reviewers, who will be blind to the identity of the author(s).

We accept articles in English and/or Russian. The recommended length of the article is 5,000 words, not including the bibliography and appendices. Please visit the Journal's website for more detailed <u>author's guidelines</u>.
